This year Marcon can report the following sales/charters we have been involved with:

BIBBY LINE GROUP of Liverpool, UK sold their 1983 built 136'x122' jack-up accommodations platform "*BIBBY PROVIDER*" to MOHAMMAD AL-MOJIL GROUP of Dammam, Saudi Arabia.

OCEAN MARINE SERVICES of Kirkland, WA chartered the 168' 3000BHP tug supply boat "*CHAMPION*" to a local Pacific Northwest fishing company for the winter pollock season in the Bering Sea/Gulf of Alaska to be used in conjunction with their fishing fleet as a spotter vessel.

MARIANAS TUG AND BARGE of Saipan has purchased a newbuilding 210'x60' ocean deck barge built by Jiangyin Shipyard, People's Republic of China.

PROGRESSIVE MARINE of Bethpage, New York has bought the 106'x32' 2300SHP aluminum catamaran research vessel "*RIDGELY WARFIELD*" built 1967 by Bethlehem Steel.

GENERAL PETROLEUM of Long Beach, CA purchased the 808 BBL small inland tank barge "*PENMAR I*" from Pacific Treatment Environmental Services of El Cajon. The barge will be used to transport and supply ships with lube oil in Long Beach Harbor.

ZAKHER MARINE OILFIELD SERVICES of Abu Dhabi purchased the 4130BHP 185' tug supply boat "OIL SUPPLIER" (ex-Mantarraya) built 1972 from U.K. Sellers. Vessel will be refurbished at OFFSHORE SHIPBUILDING's yard in Palatka, Florida.

BAY MARINE CONTRACTING of Olympia, WA has taken the 1200BHP pushboat "PASTOL BAY" on a longterm lease purchase from HARPAC EQUIPMENT LEASING, INC. of Seattle, Washington.

CHIQUITA BANANA dba GREAT WHITE FLEET purchased from POWELL BROS. BARGE TERMINAL the 1400BHP twin screw tug "SEA HAWK" for their shipdocking operations in Mexico. The 68' tug was built in 1980 for shallow water ops in the Caribbean and is powered by twin GM12V149 diesels.

MARIDIVE & OIL SERVICES of Egypt purchased the 192' 3000BHP 1981 built "PETROMAR DORADO" from the U.S. Maritime Administration. Vessel will be re-flagged and is being refitted in a U.S. Gulf Coast yard prior to sailing to mid-East to be used in Maridive's existing operations.

MARINE SUPPLY C.A., Caracas purchased the tug 1800BHP "ALBERT G" from MOVEABLE BOATS of Lockport, LA. The 85' tug was built in 1982 in by Turnship and is powered by twin GM16V149 diesels with kort. Now renamed "SABINE IV" she will be use in oilfield service off Maracaibo.

CITY OF ROTTERDAM purchased 5 fiberglass LASH barges from DELTA MARINE SERVICE of Mobile. Barges will be used as part of a museum displaying marine artifacts in Rotterdam Harbor.

Venezuelan buyers purchased the 65' triple screw 1020BHP tug "MARLENA" built '67 from S.C. LOVELAND of New Jersey for service in Lake Maracaibo. Tug will be delivered by mid-August.

NEWPORT PETROLEUM of Seal Beach, California has bareboat chartered the 70,000BBL 7500dwt ocean self-heating petroleum barge "E-67" (built 1981) from Eklof Marine Corp. of New York. The barge is now in service on the U.S. West Coast transporting dirty products.
